**MEMORANDUM ON  
THE EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS  
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EXCHANGE AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
NARESUAN UNIVERSITY IN THAILAND  
AND  
KANAZAWA UNIVERSITY IN JAPAN**




Naresuan University in Thailand and Kanazawa University in Japan shall engage in the mutual exchange of students (hereinafter referred to as the Exchange Program) in accordance with the Agreement executed on the .....<sup>26<sup>th</sup></sup>.....of .....September....., 2013 in order to strengthen the bonds of good will and friendship between the two institutions.


1. Both institutions shall accept up to two exchange students per year. They shall exchange the same number of students in principle. However, the two institutions will accept more than two students on condition that there shall not be an imbalance in the number of students. The enrollment period shall not exceed 12 months.
2. The home institution shall select candidates who are academically prepared to benefit from the Exchange Program, and recommend them to the host institution. The host institution shall decide on their eligibility to the Exchange Program.
3. The Exchange Program starts in either January or August at Naresuan University and in either April or October at Kanazawa University.
4. Both institutions shall accept exchange students as non-degree students.
5. The home institution shall acknowledge that exchange students enrolling in courses or conducting research shall abide by the enrollment requirements of the host institution.
6. Fees for tuition, enrollment, and the entrance examination at the host institution will be waived.
7. Both institutions shall provide, in advance, all necessary information under the Exchange Program and available scholarships. Both institutions shall notify the home institution, in advance, of expenses (e.g. costs for housing, board, health insurance, alien registration fees, and other personal expenses) to be covered by the exchange students.
8. Both institutions shall provide appropriate academic advice, orientation, counseling and guidance to exchange students during the duration of the exchange program.

9. Both institutions will assist exchange students in locating housing in a student dormitory or other affordable and safe accommodation.
10. Exchange students shall have appropriate insurance that covers health, injury and damage, and any other insurance as recommended by the host institution.
11. The host institution may terminate the official status of exchange students in the following situations:
  - (1) Students are unable to continue their studies due to financial or health reasons; or
  - (2) Students fail to maintain satisfactory academic performances; or
  - (3) Students violate the laws of the host country or the regulations of the host institution.
12. The host institution shall evaluate academic performances of the exchange students and prepare their official transcript (or an evaluation of research results) with the approval of the faculty or graduate school. In addition, the host institution shall provide it to the home institution when it is requested.
13. Credits shall be awarded for courses or research work conducted by exchange students at the host institution according to the standard set by the home institution.
14. This memorandum shall remain in force for a period of three years, after which it shall continue unless either party expresses, in writing, its intention to amend it or terminate it.

This memorandum is signed in two copies in English, and each party shall retain one copy.


**AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE  
BETWEEN  
NARESUAN UNIVERSITY IN THAILAND  
AND  
KANAZAWA UNIVERSITY IN JAPAN**




Naresuan University in Thailand and Kanazawa University in Japan enter into the following terms of agreement with respect to furthering scholarly and educational exchanges.

1. Both universities agree to cooperate in a spirit of mutual understanding and goodwill and to strengthen our ties of friendship.
2. Both universities will make an effort to promote and develop cooperation in the following activities.
  - (1) Exchange of faculty members and research fellows.
  - (2) Exchange of students.
  - (3) Exchange of academic materials, publications, and information.
  - (4) Conducting joint research projects and organization of symposiums.
  - (5) Other activities that contribute to the development of academic and educational exchange between the two universities.
3. This agreement does not include any immediate funding; however, both universities shall support their joint programs, whenever it is feasible. In general, each side shall bear the cost for its participation in projects and activities unless otherwise agreed upon.
4. Implementation of this agreement shall be discussed and agreed upon by both institutions. If necessary, a memorandum on implementation shall be made by the appropriate representatives of both parties.
5. Through such activities, both universities shall promote friendship and goodwill between Thailand and Japan and shall contribute to the academic and cultural benefit of both nations.

6. This agreement shall come into effect on the date of signing by both parties and remain in effect for a period of five years from the date of signing. Either university may terminate the agreement, or request its revision, in advance of the expiration date of the agreement by providing the other university with six months prior written notice of its intentions. In this case, the programs or the activities that have already been approved by both parties by the date of the written notice shall be allowed completion under the conditions of the agreement. This agreement is subject to an automatic renewal for a period of five years in the event that there are no requests for termination or revision.
7. This agreement is signed in two copies in English, and each party shall retain one copy.

Additionally, those with Japanese nationality are not eligible for the JASSO scholarship.
7. Applications from applicants currently enlisted in military service will not be accepted.
8. Tuition
  - (1) Tuition shall be waived for students who are from institutions that have concluded an agreement on mutual tuition waiver with Kanazawa University according to the number of students specified in the agreement. For details, please confirm with their home institution.
  - (2) For students in Kanazawa University Japanese Language and Culture Program receiving a Japanese government (MEXT) scholarship, there are no tuition fees regardless of the number of exchange students or agreement on tuition waiver.
9. Accommodations  
Kanazawa University will arrange for your accommodation. (If the number of students who want to live in the accommodations arranged by Kanazawa University exceeds the number of vacant rooms or if students want to live in private apartments rather than the accommodations arranged by Kanazawa University, they must arrange for housing themselves. In that case, the monthly rent for an apartment [one bedroom with kitchenette, toilet and bath, unfurnished] in Kanazawa is from 40,000 to 60,000 yen and the deposit and “key money” nonrefundable will be approximately 150,000 to 300,000 yen. Also, students will be required to take out insurance. Real estate agents provide information on apartments and housing. Japanese apartments do not usually include furniture and fixtures.)

#### 10. Living Expenses

Standard monthly living expenses in Kanazawa can be considered to be from around 80,000 to 100,000 yen. Please be sure to have sufficient funds available to cover your living expenses during the study period.

- Rent: 30,000 to 50,000 yen
- Electricity, water, and other utilities: about 10,000 yen
- Health insurance: 1,600 yen
- Food: 25,000 to 30,000 yen
- Miscellaneous expenses: 30,000 to 40,000 yen

For students who don't have any expectations to receive scholarship before arriving at Japan, few scholarships can be applied for after enrolled in Kanazawa University. Please be sure to prepare sufficient funds available to cover your living expenses before coming to Japan.

#### 11. National Health Insurance

All international students at Kanazawa University are required to join the National Health Insurance program. It costs about 1,500 yen per month. This insurance covers around 70% of costs for medical care and hospitalization.

#### 12. Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research ("Gakkensai")

All international students at Kanazawa University are required to take out Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research. It costs 1,000 yen per year. This insurance protects students against physical injuries arising from unexpected accidents during their educational and research activities.

#### 13. Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with "Gakkensai" for International Students

All international students are required to join the Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with "Gakkensai" for International Students. The premium per year is 1,860 yen (treatment cost not covered) or 11,500 yen (treatment cost covered). The premium every six months is 1,310 yen (treatment cost not covered) or 8,060 yen (treatment cost covered).

This insurance covers injury, disease, and liability for compensation not only during regular curricular activities but also in daily life.

#### 14. Immigration to Japan

There are certain formalities that must be observed by international students intending to pursue studies in Japan. Before entering Japan, students are required to apply at their nearest Japanese diplomatic mission (embassy or consulate) for a "College Student" visa. A College Student visa will only be issued after the diplomatic mission is in possession of the applicant's "Certificate of Eligibility." However, Japanese government scholarship (MEXT) students undertaking Kanazawa University Japanese Language and Culture Program need to obtain a visa by other means. The Student Affairs Division of Kanazawa University shall submit applications for the Certificate of Eligibility to the immigration office at Kanazawa on behalf of exchange students. The Certificate of Eligibility will then be sent to the students. When applying for the visa, students must take the Certificate of Eligibility and their passport to the diplomatic mission. Students should also be sure to bring the Certificate of Eligibility with them and show it to immigration authorities at the airport when they enter Japan.

Exchange students who enroll in the College of Human and Social Sciences • Graduate School of Human and Socio-Environmental Studies • Graduate School of Law will attend regular courses offered by the Academic Field or the Graduate School, or conduct research in their field of specialization at the graduate school.

Exchange students who enroll in the College of Transdisciplinary Sciences for Innovation, the College of Science and Engineering, the College of Medical, Pharmaceutical and Health Sciences, the Graduate School of Natural Science and Technology, the Graduate School of Medical Sciences, the Graduate School of Advanced Preventive Medical Sciences, and the Graduate School of Frontier Science Initiative will take "Specialized Seminar (required)," "Specialized Research," "Specialized Experiment," and other specialized courses in Japanese or English based on their own

\*However, English native speaker do not need to submit B. And if any of the following students who can submit below certificate do not need to submit B.

- Bachelor's degree or Master's degree (expected to be acquired) from USA, Canada, UK, Ireland, Australia, and New Zealand
- A graduation or completion certificate (expected to be acquired) of the degree acquisition program in English

※If you cannot submit the certificate A or B, we accept the certificate of Japanese or English proficiency which is made by the certificate format designated by Kanazawa University (in the attached sheet) .

\*The certificate must be proofed by the Japanese or English instructor.

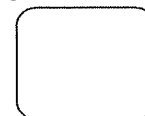

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## Notice on KUEP in Kanazawa University Hospital

### 1. Common rules

- ① I promise to learn medicine with respect for the patients.
- ② I promise to surely follow and act by the instructions of the teacher in charge .
- ③ I promise to be careful of what my manner of speaking, appearance, and attitude.
- ④ I promise not to make unnecessary conversation or action while I participate in KUEP.
- ⑤ I promise to turn off my mobile phone and other handy devices while I participate in KUEP.
- ⑥ I promise not to let out personal information and what I come to know while I participate in KUEP.
- ⑦ I promise to be on time.
- ⑧ I promise to let my teacher in charge know beforehand when I cannot participate in KUEP due to sickness, etc.

### 2. About handling personal information

Every participant of KUEP is responsible for obeying rules provided by the hospital.

The College of Medical, Pharmaceutical and Health Sciences have set “The regulations about treatment of personal information at hospital” and if he/she violates the regulations, he/she will be punished accordingly.

- ① You must not copy personal information of patients etc. without permission of the teacher in charge.
- ② If you copy personal information of patients etc., you must blacken out the parts of that may identify individuals so that their personal information are not let out.
- ③ If you copy personal information of patients, etc., you must keep it properly.  
When you discard the copy, you must take appropriate precautions so that individuals may not be identified, such as using the shredder.
- ④ You must not take out the copies of personal information from the hospital etc. without permission of your teacher in charge.
- ⑤ You must not use, show, say, and give their personal information that you obtain in the hospital, etc. for any purpose other than KUEP.
- ⑥ You must not use the computer and peripheral equipment (hard-disk, memories and so on) with recorded personal information in the hospital etc. without the permission of the use.
- ⑦ When using computer and other devices during observation, you must abide by the regulations of the hospital, etc. and you must not browse or copy personal information except for what is justly used in the program.
- ⑧ You must not delete, falsify or destroy the data of the hospital, etc.
- ⑨ You must not speak in a public space (the corridor, the elevator, the toilet, the coffee shop, the dining room, on the road to go to school etc.) about personal information because it may let out the information.
- ⑩ You must not upload or share personal information of patients etc. on the computer network (for example, E-mail, Blog, SNS such as Twitter, Line, etc.), where the third party may see .

### 3. Relationship with patients

- ① You must not give or take money and goods with patients and their family. If you have difficulty rejecting proposals from patients or their family, say you will discuss the matter with your teacher in charge, and report the situation to the teacher promptly.
- ② You must consult your teacher in charge in case there are questions or requests of patients you cannot address on your own.
- ③ You must report to your teacher in charge of any request from patients and their family and what you did on the very day of such request.
- ④ You must abide by the instructions of your teacher in charge about relationship with patients after KUEP.

### 4. About clothes and appearance

- ① You must wear the white gown or suitable other clothes for KUEP.
- ② You must wear your name plate.
- ③ You must keep clean your hair, hand, fingers, and nails (long hair must be bundled up, nails must be cut short, hands must be thoroughly washed and so on), and take care of not to displease the people around you.
- ④ You must put on shoes that do not make sound when walking; for example, wear clean and comfortable white shoes.  
You must abide by the hospital rules which may require you to use different pairs of shoes for indoor and outdoor use. (You should not wear slippers.)
- ⑤ You must not wear your white gown outside of the hospital area (public traffic etc.) for sanitary reasons.

### 5. Other notices

- ① There are rules of each department. You must be aware of these rules and are not trouble the people there.
- ② When you use tools in the department, make sure whether you are allowed to use it, and be sure to get a permission. Do not use or take out without permission.
- ③ You must eat only in the permitted place.
- ④ Since food and drink at the department are not prepared for students, you must not consume them.
- ⑤ Keep out of the places that are not permitted for students to enter and are locked.
- ⑥ You must not smoke in Kanazawa University Hospital and Takara-machi campus.
- ⑦ You must not use tables and chairs in waiting floor and break rooms while wearing your white gown because they are for the patients to use.
